	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Low-top athletic shoes with non-marking rubber soles. Shoes should not extend up above the ankle.</li> <li>✓ Black and Brown flat Mary-Janes shoes with a strap</li> <li>✓ Vans are permitted (solid colors only)</li> <li>✓ Base, sole and accent colors must be white, black, brown, grey or navy blue (no exceptions)</li> <li>✓ "branding," "stripes," or "side logos" must be white, black, brown, grey or navy blue</li> <li>✓ Solid color(s) are acceptable</li> <li>✓ Shoelaces must match one another and the main shoe color(s)</li> <li>✓ Shoelaces must always be tied in the traditional way</li> <li>✓ Velcro closures are acceptable.</li> <li>✓ Closed toe and heel shoes are mandatory</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>X Mid top or high-top shoes during the school day</li> <li>X No colors other than white, black, brown, grey or navy blue (no other shades of blue allowed)</li> <li>X Character shoes or patterns that are visible</li> <li>X Different color or patterned shoelaces</li> <li>X Shoes laced but not tied</li> <li>X Light up shoes or wheelies</li> <li>X Flip-flops, sandals, crocs, and open toe or open back shoes</li> <li>X UGG style, tall shaft, ankle, hiking, and cowboy boots</li> <li>X Snow boots are allowed to be worn to and from school and outside at recess but must be exchanged for dress code compliant footwear once in the classroom</li> </ul>
